BY-LAW 2927

A By-law to prohibit the operation of motorized snow vehicles
on any sidewalk or boulevard within the Corporation.

WHEREAS it has been deemed expedient in the interest of public safety that motorized snow vehicles should not be operated on any sidewalk or boulevard within the Corporation.

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF MIDLAND ENACTS AND BE IT ENACTED AS FOLLOWS:

1. No person shall operate a motorized snow vehicle along any sidewalk or boulevard within the Corporation of the Town of Midland.
2. For the purposes of this By-law a motorized snow vehicle means a self-propelled vehicle designed to be driven exclusively on snow or ice or both.
3. Any person who contravenes any provision of the by-law is guilty of an offence and on conviction is liable to a fine as provided for in the Provincial Offences Act, R.S.O. 1990, as amended.

This By-law shall come into force and take effect immediately after the final passing hereof.

By-law read a first, second and third time and finally passed at a meeting of the Municipal Council of the Town of Midland this 8th day of December A.D. 1969.
