BY-LAW 98-3

A By-law to amend By-law 2927, being a by-law to prohibit the operation of motorized snow vehicles on any sidewalk or boulevard within the Corporation. _____

WHEREAS Council passed By-law 2927 on the Eighth day of December, 1969, to prohibit the operation of motorized snow vehicles on any sidewalk or boulevard within the Corporation; and

WHEREAS Council passed By-law 96-8 on the Twenty-second day of January, 1996, amending By-law 2927; and

WHEREAS Council has reviewed the by-law and now deems it expedient to further amend the said by-law;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MIDLAND ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Section 3, of By-law 2927, as amended by By-law 96-8, be deleted and replaced with the following:

Any person who contravenes any provision of the by-law is guilty of an offence and on conviction is liable to a fine as provided for in the Provincial Offences Act, R.S.O. 1990, as amended.

2. This by-law shall come into force and effect on the Municipality receiving approval for set fines relating to provisions in this by-law from the Ministry of the Solicitor General.

By-law read a first, second and third time and finally passed in Open Council on the Twenty-seventh day of January, 1998.
