Harbour Rules and Regulations



1. Garbage and Recycling bins are available in the designated area of the facility; there must be no spillage of garbage, sewage, fuels, oils, or other pollutants on or about the Marina premises or waterways. Please contact the Marina Office for any disposal inquiries.
2. Propane regulated barbecues are permitted on the docks but must be attended by an adult at all times. No open flames or fire pits are permitted on the Marina property.
3. Fire extinguishers are available throughout the marina facility for emergencies. Please report all fire extinguisher usage to the Marina office.
4. Pets are permitted on the Marina premises, but must be kept on a leash and under control at all times. Excessive barking will not be tolerated. Dogs must not be tied on the docks in any way that may hinder or impede the safety of the walkways. It is the pet owner's responsibility to "stoop and scoop". Pet owners may be refused the privilege of bringing their pets to the marina property should they fail to comply with these rules.
5. In order to respect the close proximity of neighbours, an 11:00 pm to 7:00 am noise curfew, music and loud voices must be turned to a low level so as not to bother any sleeping boaters. Please exercise good judgement and consideration at all times.
6. Washrooms must be kept clean and tidy. Children must be supervised therein. Pets are not allowed in the washroom facilities.
7. Speed must be at dead slow when entering and leaving the Marina, and throughout the Harbour. As a courtesy to our neighbours please keep your wake minimal until reaching open water.
8. Boat handling throughout the marina shall be the responsibility of the owner to ensure their vessel is handled in a safe and prudent manner. Small crafts shall give the right-of-way to larger vessels.
9. Any abuse of alcohol, fighting, offensive language complaints or acts of rude conduct toward any other boater, guest or marina staff will not be tolerated. Clients acknowledge that, with this rental agreement, such behaviour is grounds for the marina, at their sole discretion, to cancel docking privileges without any refund.
10. An emergency phone is located between shelters on the Rotary Pier. Call 911 or 526-2201 for the Midland Police Services.
11. Renter will only use the slip designated, we reserve the right to require the vessel to be moved from one location to another within the marina after 72 hours' notice.
12. We have the right to refuse or cancel any docking permit.
13. Renter does not have the right to assign a slip to another party.
14. All boaters are responsible for their own boats – regarding mooring lines, anchoring. Any damage or theft done to any boater property is not the responsibility of the marina.
