County hosts Open Houses to update public on the status of the Archaeological Management Plan

Midhurst/ October 19, 2018 – The County is hosting Open House sessions in early November to update the public on the progress of the Simcoe County Archaeological Management Plan (AMP). The AMP project is being undertaken by the County's Planning department to identify, protect and conserve Simcoe County's archaeological features and address municipal planning requirements.

The scheduled Open House sessions include a brief presentation on draft archaeological mapping, policies, procedures and recommendations based on feedback received during the consultation process to-date. Presentations will be consistent at each meeting. Attendees will have the opportunity to discuss the project one-on-one with the County's archaeological consultants and County Planning staff. TAKE NOTICE that an application to the Committee of Adjustment has been submitted for a Provisional Consent to Sever pursuant to Section 53 of the *Planning Act*, c.P.13, R.S.O. 1990 as amended for lands known municipally as **467 Aberdeen Boulevard** in the Town of Midland.

The property is designated **Residential District** in the Official Plan and zoned **Residential – R2-1** and **Open Space - OS** in Zoning By-law 2004-90, as amended.

THE PURPOSE OF THE APPLICATION is for consent to sever a portion of land at 467 Aberdeen Boulevard, for lot addition purposes, having a Lot Frontage of 7.24 metres and Lot Area of 937 square metres which will be merged with the adjacent property at 459 Aberdeen Boulevard. 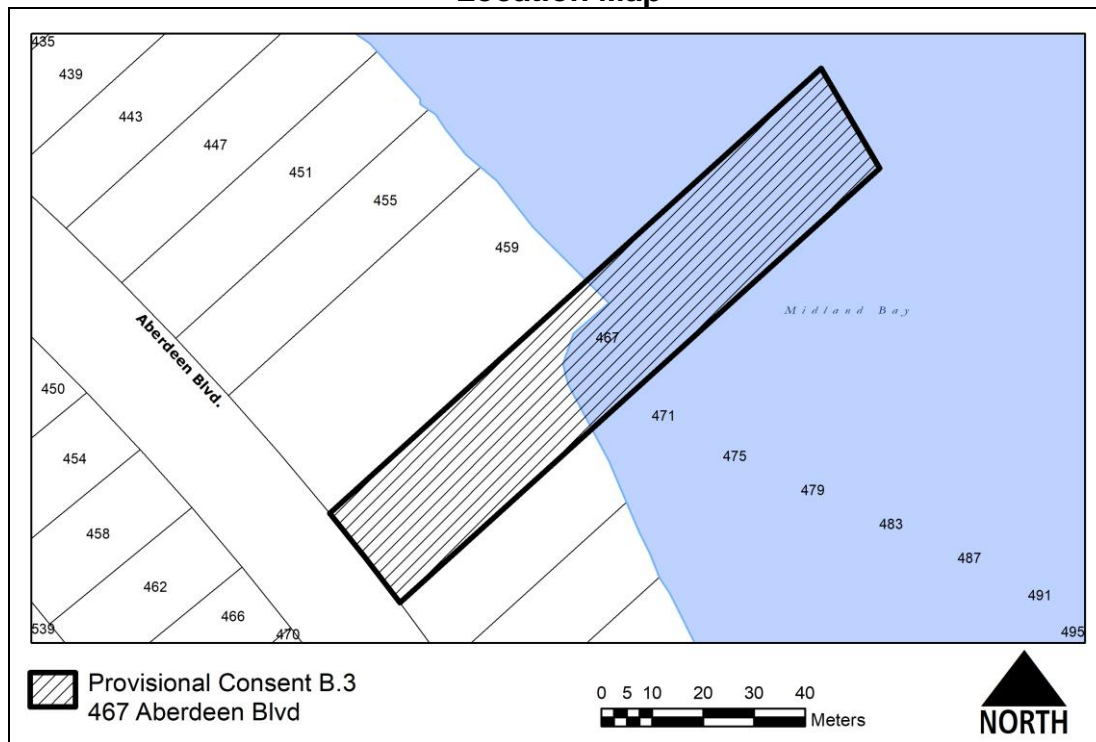

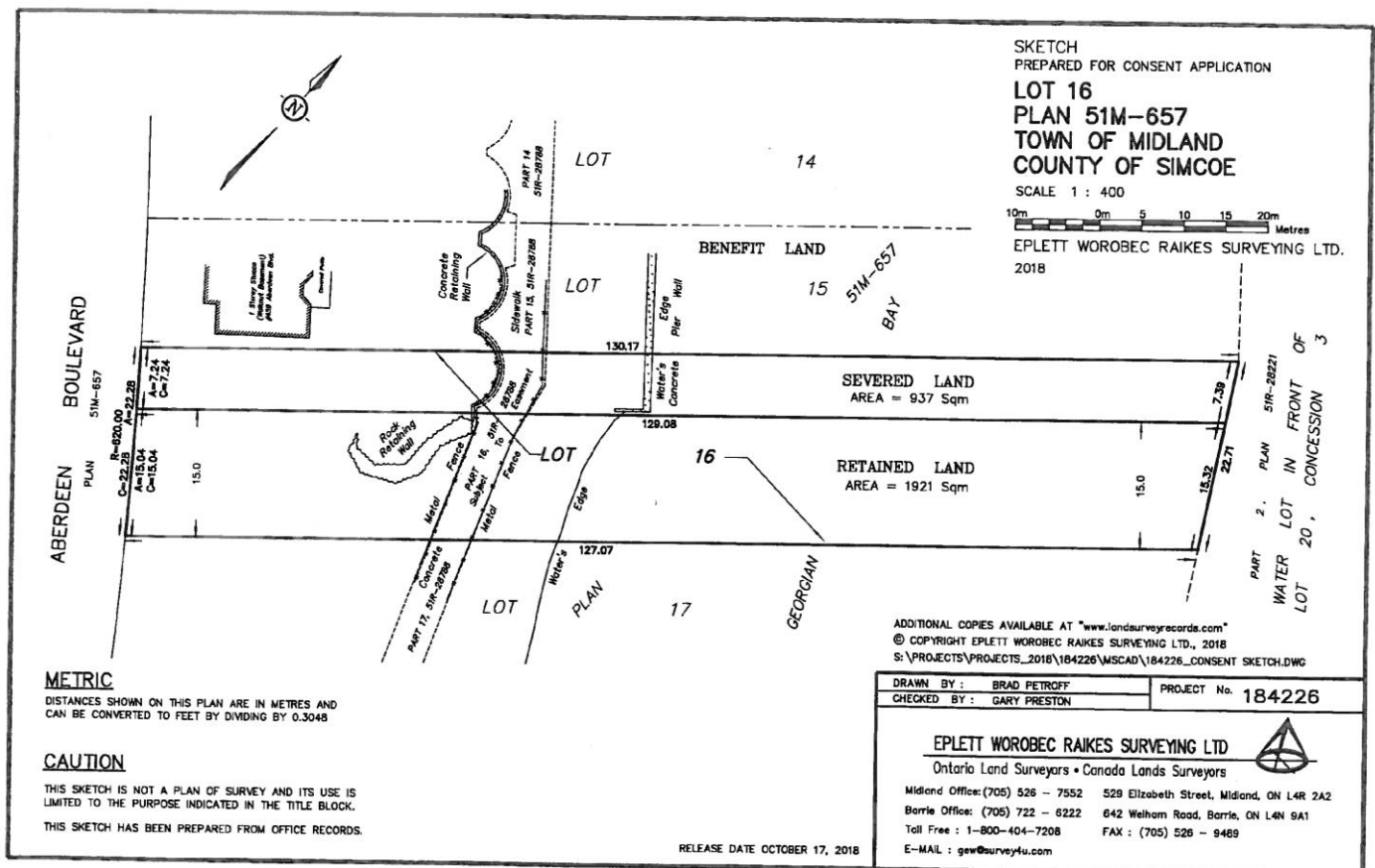

Sign Variance Application C.6/2018**

TAKE NOTICE that an application to the Sign Variance Committee has been submitted for a variance to the Sign By-law 2011-79, as amended, pursuant to Part 9.1.5 under the Sign By-law 2011-79, as amended, for lands known municipally as **16825 Highway 12**.

The property is designated **EMPLOYMENT AREAS** in the Official Plan and zoned **Highway Commercial - HC** in Zoning By-law 2004-90, as amended.

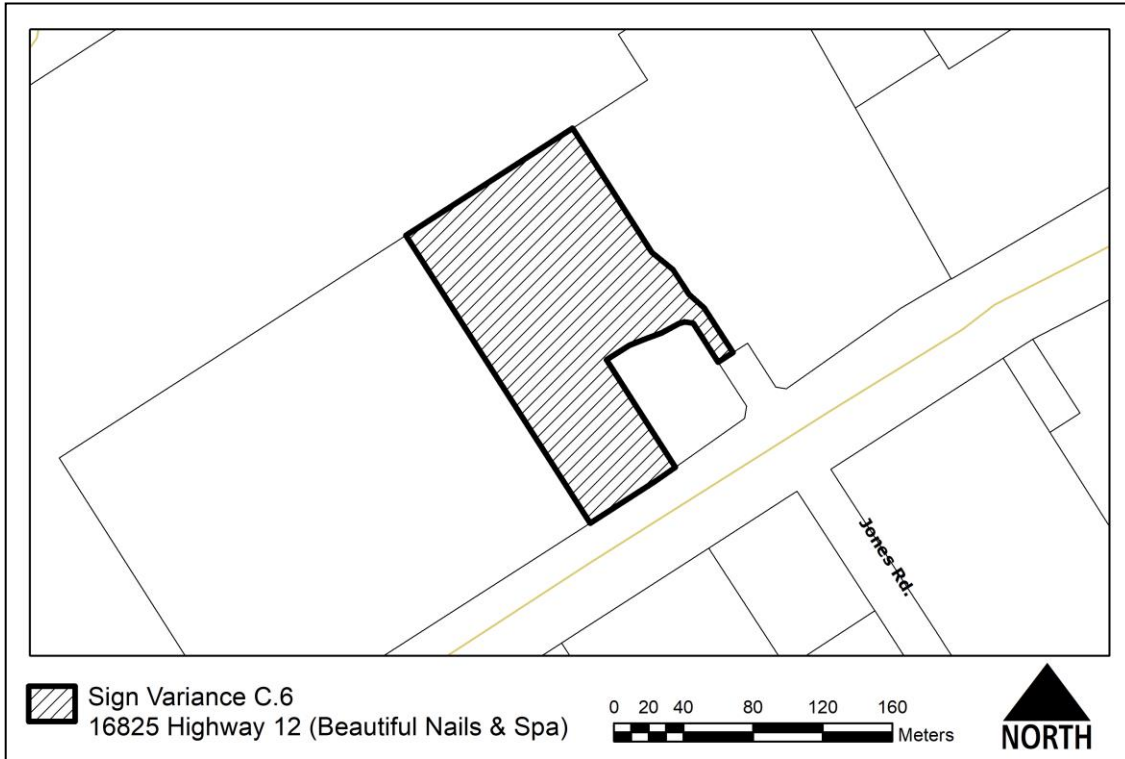


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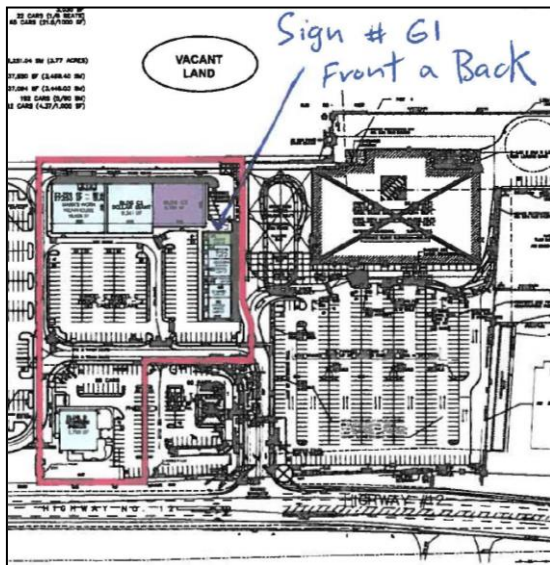
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Sign Variance Application C.6/2018
