Municipal Class Environmental Assessment Study

Notice of Public Information Centre

Background

The County of Simcoe, in partnership with the Towns of Midland and Penetanguishene, is proposing to upgrade County Road 93 (Penetanguishene Road) from Highway 12 in Midland to Thompsons Road in Penetanguishene. The study area is shown on the map provided on the reverse of this notice.

The proposed upgrades will be planned within the framework of the Complete Streets concept and in consideration of the natural, socio-economic and heritage environments, the needs of motor vehicles, pedestrians and cyclists, County of Simcoe and Town of Midland/Town of Penetanguishene standards, and surface drainage requirements with the objective of providing safe and efficient travel for all road users.

Study Process

The County is proceeding with a Schedule B Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (EA) to consider the impacts associated with the proposed upgrades. The Class EA process will address:

- existing traffic operations and conditions on County Road 93 and at its key intersections;
- alternative solutions to implementing Active Transportation facilities for pedestrians and cyclists;
- the location, extent and sensitivity of the existing environments within the area;
- the potential impacts of each alternative to the noted environments and mitigating measures;
- public and agency consultation and participation; and
- an assessment and evaluation of the alternatives culminating in a preferred solution.

Given the various differences and challenges along the corridor, the urban and rural sections will be addressed separately, to ensure the most appropriate solution in context of existing conditions.

Following completion of the PIC, and in consideration of comments received through the consultation process, the preferred solution will be identified for further study.
