In submitting this application form, it is understood that:

- The selected artist will be required to enter into an agreement with the Town of Midland.
- The mural(s) will be completed within the timeline specified in the Call for Artists.
- Public health guidelines will be followed when collecting the alupanel(s) and delivering completed murals.
- The Artist will retain copyright of the artwork. The artwork must be original and not violate the copyright of any other person.
- Use of text is permitted, however profanity, advertising, branding and/or promotion of contempt against anyone are prohibited.
- Proposals must be inclusive and respect the rights of Indigenous people to own and control their heritage, including Indigenous images, design, stories, and other cultural expression.
- Ownership of the artwork will be assigned to the Town of Midland and maintained per the Public Art Policy. The Town has the right to record the installation and display of the artwork and reproduce images of the artwork for promotional and municipal purposes.
- Information on this form is collected pursuant to the Municipal Act, 2001 and the Town of Midland is subject to the Municipal Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act therefore this information and any records provided may be subject to public disclosure under that Act.
- The Town of Midland reserves the right to reject any and all submissions, as well as completed works which do not adhere to criteria and guidelines.
