



Town of Midland, King Street Rejuvenation Project Newsletter – March 2021

Construction Information & Schedule

Residents and business owners in Midland are advised the remaining work and final touches of the King Street Rejuvenation project are scheduled to be completed in Spring 2021. The work generally includes:

1. Intersection crosswalk installation at Bayshore Drive, Dominion Avenue, Hugel Avenue, Elizabeth Street and Yonge Street. Mid-block crosswalk installation between Hugel Avenue and Elizabeth Street and between Elizabeth Street and Yonge Street.
2. All plantings within the construction limits.
3. Unit paver and concrete walkway works at the northwest corner of Yonge Street and King Street.
4. Bicycle rack, tree guard and bench installation.
5. Rejuvenation work within Neezhoday Park (adjacent to the Midland Public Library), including new unit pavers and concrete sidewalk.
6. Restoration works within the Alley adjacent to 284 King Street.

Weather permitting, Arnott Construction is scheduled to mobilize in early April and expect to be complete by the end of May.

Road Closures

King Street will remain open throughout the 2021 construction with isolated closures to facilitate the installation of the crosswalks. Only one intersection will be closed at a time and Arnott will erect detour signage to direct traffic flow.

Site Safety

Construction involves the use of heavy equipment and the unavoidable creation of obstacles (excavations, etc.). Arnott will be responsible for creating a safe working environment within the project limits; however, we ask that you take extra caution during the construction period to ensure everyone's safety.
