RAIN OR SHINE!

Background – In 1992 the Town of Midland in conjunction with the Canada Day Committee, held a day long festival in celebration of Canada’s 125th birthday. This tradition continues today, and we expect more than 10,000 visitors to attend this event.

Eligibility – Each participant is responsible for remitting their own taxes. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to limit the entries based on product categories, on a first come first served basis. Emphasis is on quality of workmanship. Space allotment is final. Any special requests will be taken into consideration at the time of application; however, we regret we cannot make any guarantees.

Set Up Times –Set up is between the hours of 8:00 am and 9:30 am on the morning of July 1st. No entry to the park will be granted other than during these times.

Exhibitors must be set up by 11:00 am and are expected to stay until at least 4:00 pm.

Promotion – Attendance is expected to exceed 10,000 visitors and an extensive print and radio campaign will be engaged for the festival.

Fee and Space Allotment – Booth sizes are approximately 10 feet wide x 10 feet deep. The cost is \$80.00 per booth. **Notice:** Upon acceptance, Canada Day exhibition fees are non-refundable.

Deadline – Applications must be received no later than **June 19th, 2020**. All applicants will be notified by email no later than June 26th, 2019. (You must include an email address on your application.)
