

DID YOU KNOW?

Snow or ice buildup could damage your gas meter, interrupt your gas supply, and cause your furnace to malfunction, or lead to a deadly Carbon Monoxide build up in your home.



During the winter, and especially after a storm, keep an eye on your natural gas meter and appliance exhaust vents.

- Use a snow brush or broom to gently clear any snow or ice
- Be careful using your shovel, plow or snow blower nearby
- Don't kick, hit or use sharp objects to remove snow or ice
- Never use salt, hot water or ice melting chemicals to remove snow or ice
- Repair leaky eaves troughs or downspouts to prevent water from dripping on your gas meter or vents
- Don't pile snow up against your gas meter or appliance vents
- Ensure you have a working Carbon Monoxide alarm adjacent to all sleeping areas in your home
