

DID YOU KNOW?

You should inspect and clean your gas barbecue before using it for the first time each season!



Always check cylinder & gas connections for leaks before using your barbecue for the first time, if you smell gas, or any time you replace the cylinder.

- Apply a light soap and water solution to the cylinder and gas connections using a brush or spray bottle to check for leaks (never use a match or open flame).
- BBQ grills should only be used outdoors.
- The BBQ should be placed well away from the house, deck railings, and out from under the eaves.
- Never use a BBQ in a garage.
- Keep children and pets at least three feet away from the grilling area.
- Never leave your BBQ unattended when lit.
- Always make sure your BBQ lid is in the open position before lighting.
- Install and maintain smoke and carbon monoxide alarms in your home.
