



# Mid-Pen Transit - REVISED Detour North and South Routes (Downtown Midland) July 20, 2020 to November 30, 2020



Due to the progress of the King Street Rejuvenation Project, King Street from Elizabeth Street to Yonge Street and Elizabeth Street (at King) will be closed starting on July 20, 2020. As a result, both the North (Blue) and South (Red) transit routes in Midland will require detours as shown on this map starting on July 20, 2020 and lasting until approximately November 30, 2020.

The stop/shelter at King and Elizabeth Streets has been closed and a temporary stop has been placed on Midland Avenue just north of the public parking lot at 348 Midland Avenue. This temporary stop also marks the route changeover point for the duration of the detour. A single bus covers both Midland routes and the route changeover point is where one route is complete (either North or South) and the bus begins the other route. There is no need to switch buses.
