County Road 93 Multi-Use Trail Phase 2

The County of Simcoe has awarded the contract to Dufferin Construction Company for the construction of the County Road 93 (CR 93) Multi-Use Trail Phase 2.

The work includes the construction of a concrete trail and sidewalks within the CR 93 right-of-way from Yonge Street to approximately 80 metres north of Lanigan Drive including traffic signal upgrades at each intersection.

Dufferin Construction plans to mobilize on **August 24, 2020**. The construction is anticipated to be completed by **November 15, 2020**.

Lane Restrictions

A minimum of one lane in each direction will remain open at all times during work hours and returned to two lanes in each direction during non-working hours. Advanced warning signs will be installed on CR 93 to warn motorists of the traffic disruptions.

Sidewalk Disruptions

The sidewalks and intersection crossings will be impacted during construction. The contractor will provide signage and traffic control persons to assist with directing pedestrians to the appropriate area for walking and crossing intersections.

We ask for your patience during this time of improvements and thank you for your cooperation.

How will I get to My Business?

The Contractor will maintain access to your business. On several occasions however, direct access to CR 93 may be interrupted periodically.

Access will be restored as quickly as possible after the work is completed. The contractor will give prior notice of any access restrictions to the businesses.

Pedestrian access to businesses will be maintained during construction.

If you have any special needs for wheelchair access please advise the R.J. Burnside & Associates Limited Construction Inspector (Lyle Simpson).

Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.

Will My Services Be Affected?

Telephone, Electrical, Cable TV and Gas services should not be affected by the construction, barring any unforeseen circumstances.

Safety

Construction involves the use of heavy equipment and the unavoidable creation of obstacles.

These circumstances are attractive to children, and we ask that you caution your children to stay clear of the working area.

We ask that you take extra caution during the construction period to ensure everyone's safety.
