Town docks, marina and boat launch to remain closed

April 3, 2020 – Keeping in line with provincial restrictions for recreation and outdoor amenities, the Town of Midland has announced that the Town dock, marina and boat launch at Pete Pettersen Park will remain closed until further notice.

“These amenities have been closed for the winter, however given the current situation with the COVID-19 pandemic, the decision was made to keep them closed until further notice,” said Andy Campbell, Executive Director of Environment & Infrastructure. “These closures will help ensure there are less opportunities for residents/visitors to gather and risk spreading the virus or incur fines.”
