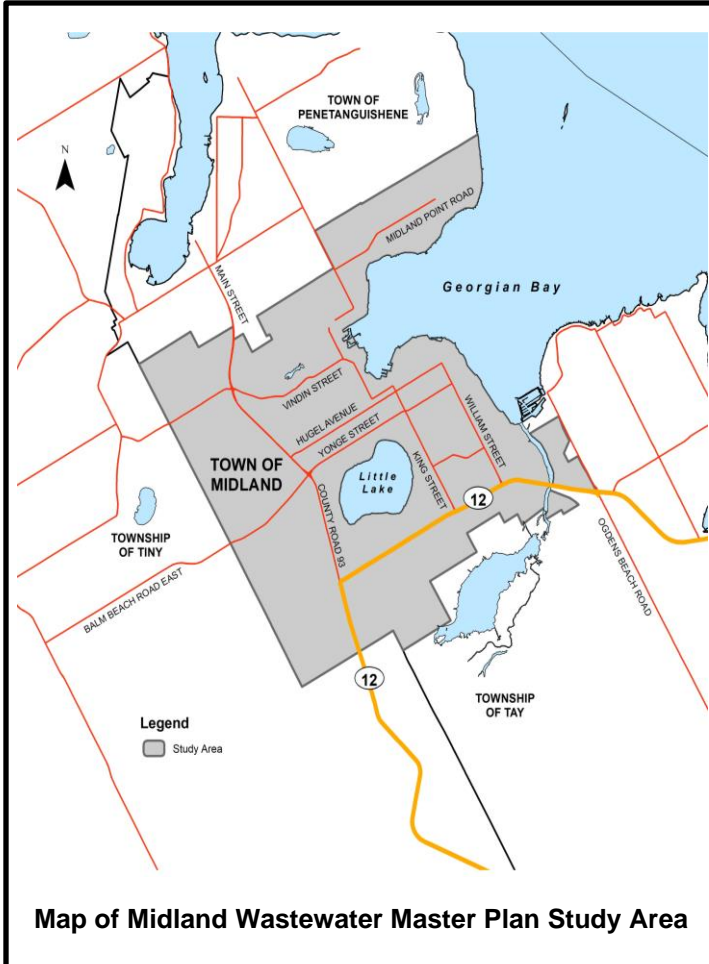




Notice of Public Information Centre

The Town of Midland has initiated a Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (Class EA) to complete a Wastewater Master Servicing Plan.

Master Plan Purpose

The purpose of this study is to understand the current wastewater system deficiencies and create a long-term infrastructure plan. This process will help to identify system requirements and assist with long-term capital planning.

Public and agency consultation is a key element of the process and input will be sought throughout the study. The proposed consultation plan provides for a Public Information Centre to review the future wastewater servicing strategies that are being considered as part of this project. This Public Information Centre will identify existing system constraints and potential alternative solutions.
