Public Engagement Sessions for MBL Planned for Early February 2023

Midland, Ontario (December 12, 2022)

Midland Bay Landing Development Corporation (MBLDC) and Georgian Communities, the Council-approved developer, will hold public engagement sessions in early February 2023 to inform the public about the MBL Master Plan and the concept plans proposed by Georgian Communities and to listen to public input on those plans.

These early sessions have been organized in response to the community's expressed desire to better understand the plans for the redevelopment of Midland Bay Landing and have an opportunity to provide their input and ideas into those redevelopment plans.

Two separate engagement sessions are scheduled:

- **Saturday, February 4, 2023**
 - To inform the public about the MBL Master Plan and the concept plans proposed by Georgian Communities plus discussions about alternative development options for MBL.
- **Saturday February 11, 2023**
 - To focus on listening to public input and suggestions about the plans.

Further details about location and time of the public engagement sessions will be provided closer to the dates. Following the sessions, MBLDC and Georgian will compile the public input received, and analyze suggestions.

With the benefit of early public input before the proposed sale of the MBL property, MBLDC will report to Council on the public input received and how the concept plans might be altered. At the same time, MBLDC will recommend to Council that they agree to execute an Agreement with Georgian Communities for the Phase 1 lands and an Option for the Phase 2 lands.

The closing of the sale of the Phase 1 lands will occur in about two years when Council approves the rezoning and site plan for the Phase 1 property during which time there will be more opportunities for further public input.
