**NOTICE OF COMPLETE APPLICATION AND
PUBLIC MEETING CONCERNING A PROPOSED
ZONING BY-LAW AMENDMENT
174 PILLSBURY DRIVE**

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Midland will hold a public meeting on **Wednesday February 17th, 2021 at 7:00 p.m.** to hear the planning merits and gather public input regarding a proposed Zoning By-law Amendment (Temporary Use) under Section 34 and Section 39 of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. P. 13, as amended. This submission is also deemed to be a *complete application* pursuant to Section 34(10.4) of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. P. 13, as amended.

Pursuant to provincial policies, public attendance at Council meetings is not permitted at this time; however, you may still participate in the public meeting as outlined below. THE PURPOSE AND EFFECT of the proposed Zoning By-law Amendment (Temporary Use) is to allow a child care centre as a temporary use. Essentially, the proposed Temporary Use By-law would establish a child care centre as a temporary permitted use for a period of 3 years.

The proposed Zoning By-law Amendment pertains to land located on the north west side of Pillsbury Drive and is legally described as Concession 3, Part Lot 18, Reference Plan 51R-18938, Part 4, Town of Midland, County of Simcoe and is municipally addressed as 174 Pillsbury Drive. The land is presently zoned as Industrial (M1) in the Town of Midland Zoning By-law No. 2004-90, as amended.

AND FURTHER TAKE NOTICE that pursuant to Section 34(10.7) of the *Planning Act*, the Application file is part of the public record and is available to the public for inspection. Any person wishing further information or clarification with regard to the application or to arrange to inspect the file should contact the Planning and Building Services Department at (705) 526-4275, extension 2214. If you are submitting letters, faxes, emails, presentations or other communications with the Town concerning this application, you should be aware that your name and the fact you communicated with the Town will become part of the public record. The Town will also make your communication and any personal information in it available to the public unless you expressly request the Town to remove it.
