



Notice of the Passing of a By-Law to Dissolve Ward Boundaries

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of The Corporation of Town of Midland passed By-law 2020-58 on the 21st day of October, 2020 pursuant to Section 222 of *the Municipal Act, 2001*.

AND TAKE NOTICE that By-law 2020-58 provides for dissolution of Wards and the implementation of an 'At-Large System of Electoral Representation'.



AND TAKE NOTICE that pursuant to Subsection 222(4) of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, any person or agency may appeal within 45 days of the passing of the by-law to the Local Planning Appeal Tribunal in respect of the by-law by filing with the Clerk of The Corporation of the Town of Midland a notice of appeal setting out the objections to the by-law and the reasons in support of the objections. This notice of appeal must be accompanied by a certified cheque or money order in the amount of \$1,100.00 made payable to the Minister of Finance.

Any notice of appeal must be filed with the Clerk's Office of the Town of Midland, at the address below, **not later than 4:30 p.m. on the 7th day of December, 2020**.
