



COUNCIL TO CONSIDER NEW OFFICIAL PLAN FOR ADOPTION

Council has set **August 15, 2019** at **6:00 p.m.** for a Special Meeting of Council to consider the Adoption of the new Official Plan for the Town of Midland. Recognizing the significant public participation and engagement throughout the full Official Plan Review process, from helping to develop the land use vision for the Town in 2016, to the supplemental reviews of the new Growth Plan and NHS in 2017 and 2018, Council has determined that a Special Meeting of Council with the new Official Plan as the sole Agenda item, is required.

In accordance with Section 17 of the *Planning Act*, the adoption of the new Official Plan is a request to the County of Simcoe to approve the new Plan as the Approval Authority. The new Official Plan requires approval by the County of Simcoe prior to coming into full force and effect. Please note appeals of the new Official Plan are to be filed with the County of Simcoe as the approval authority once a decision has been made by the County.
