**4. Site Plan Application – SPA-05-18
Seasons on Little Lake (Hanson) 16821 Highway 12**

The Committee reviewed a memorandum dated June 6, 2018 from the Planning and Building Services Department regarding a Site Plan Application with respect to the Seasons on Little Lake (Hanson) Subdivision located at 16821 Highway 12.

Angela Zhao, Planner, provided an overview of the Site Plan Application.

Also, as of September 4, 2018 the County will be offering an accessible door-to-door transit service for individuals with mobility needs called LINX+. Residents will be asked to complete a registration form to access this service through the website or by calling a toll free number.
