



Mid-Pen Transit Service Route Changes North and South Midland Routes Effective Monday, January 3, 2022



- NEW Stop/Route Changeover Point
- Regular North Route (Unchanged)
- NEW North Route (Beginning Jan. 3, 2022)
- Old North Route (No Longer Travelled as of Jan. 3, 2022)
- Regular South Route (Unchanged)
- NEW South Route (Beginning Jan. 3, 2022)
- Old South Route (No Longer Travelled as of Jan. 3, 2022)

Both the North (Blue) and South (Red) transit routes in Midland will undergo minor changes as shown on this map starting on Monday, January 3, 2022. These changes are a trial that may become permanent in the future.

A new stop has been placed on the west side of Midland Avenue just south of the intersection with Hugel Avenue beside the Bell building. A shelter may be installed at this location in the near future. This new stop also marks the Midland route changeover point. A single bus covers both Midland routes and the route changeover point is where one route is complete (either North or South) and the bus begins the other route. There is no need to switch buses.
