

# Protocols for the NSSRC Outdoor Skating Rink

---

Pursuant to [O. Reg. 263/20: Rules for Areas at Step 2](#), the following protocols have been established for the outdoor skating rink located at the NSSRC.

In incidents of non-compliance of protocols listed herein, patron(s) may be removed.

## Capacity Limits

The capacity limit shall be limited to **50 participants** at any given time and users must maintain a physical distance of at least two (2) metres from all persons outside of your household.

## Requirements that Apply to Members of the Public

Every patron should refrain, to the extent possible, from touching their eyes, nose, mouth, and other parts of the face and are strongly recommended to perform proper hand hygiene either by washing their hands or using alcohol-based hand sanitizer containing 60-90% alcohol before, during, and after attendance at the outdoor amenity.

## Screening and Self-Assessment Measures

Prior to their arrival, patrons are strongly encouraged to perform a self-assessment of COVID-19 symptoms on the day they are attending the outdoor rink using the [Ontario COVID-19 self-assessment tool \(ontario.ca\)](#).

If a patron begins to experience symptoms of COVID-19 while attending the amenity, the following actions should be taken:

- Symptomatic patrons should immediately separate themselves from others and immediately leave the site;
- Symptomatic patrons are advised to contact public health to determine if testing is required;

## Physical Distancing Measures

Patrons shall maintain the adequate physical distance of at least two (2) metres from all other patrons that are not members of your same household.

## Amenity Management Measures

Staff shall perform compliance checks as frequently as necessary to ensure the protocols listed herein are being adequately satisfied. However, the outdoor rink will be generally unsupervised by staff.
