Rules and Restrictions for Participating in Activities at the NSSRC During COVID-19

The following rules and restrictions apply to any person involved in the participation of an activity at the North Simcoe Sports and Recreation Centre during the COVID-19 Pandemic:

1. The Acknowledgement, Release, Indemnity, and Assumption of Risk waiver must be signed by all participants prior to their first session.
2. A COVID-19 Screening Questionnaire must be filled out and submitted by each participant before every session.
3. No game play or scrimmages are allowed at this time, the facility is open for training purposes only.
4. Renters are responsible for providing the facility with a Master List of the contact information from all of their participants for contact tracing purposes.
5. All participants must sign in at their designated entrance. Upon entry, they will be directed where to go by the staff member present.
6. Due to the closure of all change rooms, all participants are asked to come fully dressed until further notice. Designated areas will be set up with seating placed two metres apart for any necessary on-site changing of footwear.
7. Participants may enter 15 minutes prior to their rental time.
8. Washroom facilities will be available for urgent needs only.
9. No parents or spectators are permitted within the facility, with the exception of one parent/guardian per child under the age of 8.
10. No more than 10 people will be allowed in each allocated area at one time, this number is subject to change.
11. Participants must bring their own water bottle already filled and must take their water bottles with them when they leave.
12. Physical distancing of two metres must be maintained at all times.
13. Masks or face coverings must be worn by everyone entering the facility and may only be removed by participants playing sports, and only when they begin playing their sport.
14. Upon entering the facility, everyone must sanitize their hands.
15. Everyone entering the facility must follow all markings and signs posted within. These include arrows on the floor directing traffic flow, dedicated areas for before and after their activity, and separate entrances and exits.

Note: These rules and restrictions are subject to changes and may be updated where necessary upon further review of provincial regulations and orders over time.
