

Transportation Master Plan Update Notice of Study Commencement



The current **Transportation Master Plan (TMP)** provides an assessment of the Town's transportation improvement needs to the 2030 horizon and provides recommendations for operational design and transportation policies that the Town uses to manage its transportation infrastructure.

Many of the **short term recommendations** from the current TMP have been implemented, while many of the **longer term recommendations** have yet to be initiated and will be subject to review as part of this plan update.

During the last 6 years there have been updates to municipal growth forecasts, changes to municipal policy, and other ongoing transportation initiatives in the community. There is a continuing need to balance infrastructure requirements with the financial resources of the municipality. The Town of Midland has therefore initiated a **Transportation Master Plan Update (TMPU)** to re-evaluate the planned network in relation to **changing trends, emerging needs, and new opportunities** for multiple modes of transportation including driving, transit, cycling, and walking.

Your input is important! The Town is inviting the public and other stakeholders groups to participate in the study and to assist the team in updating the plan. The study will be undertaken in general accordance with Phases 1 and 2 of the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment Process, and will include opportunities for the public to provide input.
