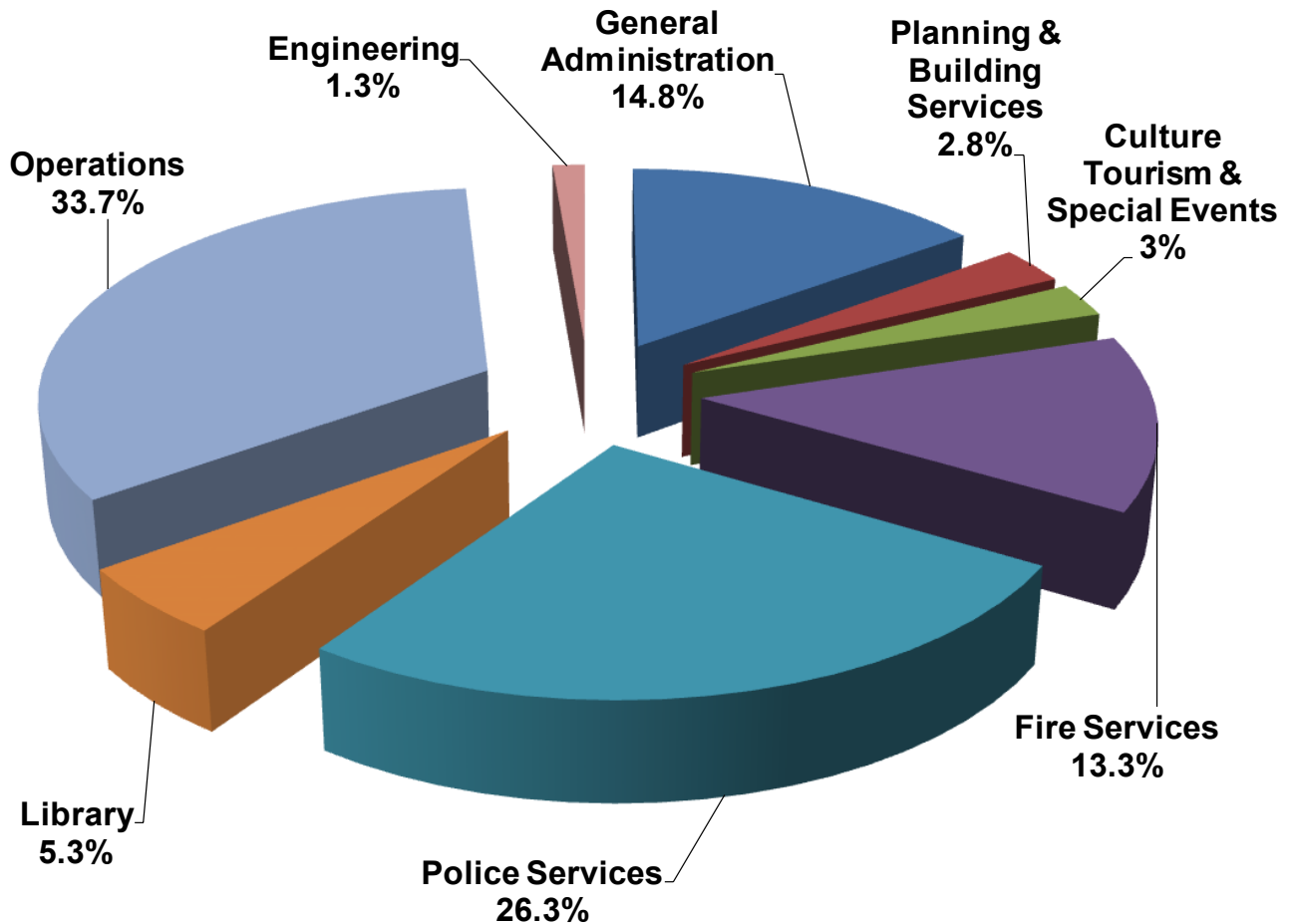




Town of Midland 2016 Taxes

Administration

Police Services

- Staffing reduced through outsourcing of dispatch, reduction of officers from 27 to 24.
- Response times to most serious calls average 3.5 minutes. 3 officers working each shift to ensure immediate response.
- Crime rates continue to drop but calls for non-criminal events are rising.
- Community Service/School officer, daily foot patrol, RIDE, traffic enforcement, immediate response and volunteers at many community events. Cram-a-Cruiser gathers approximately 12 thousand pounds in food, \$5,000 in donations for the food bank, and hundreds of toys for children.

Fire Services

- Fire Protection services include Fire Operations, Rescue Operations, Medical Assists, Public Assists and Hazardous Materials.
- Fire Prevention and Public Education services including inspections upon complaint or request to ensure buildings meet the provision of the Ontario Fire Code for the safety of residents and visitors.
- New construction plans review.
- Public education sessions to help residents better understand the dangers of fire and the need for fire prevention in everyday life.
- Training for all firefighters to meet the NFPA standard for firefighters as well as training for specialized courses.
- Emergency Management Program administration to ensure Town is ready to respond to a wide variety of emergencies.

Planning Services

- Administration of Town Official Plan, Zoning By-law and Provincial legislation.
- Manages local planning review processes for all development applications including amendments to Official Plan and Zoning By-law, Site Plan, Subdivision and Condo approvals.
- Responsible for Committee of Adjustment and Sign Variance Committee.
- Midland Heritage Committee.

Building Services

- Building Services is responsible for the receipt and issuance of building permit applications and inspections as part of the regulation and enforcement of the Ontario Building Code.

Operations

- Public Works Equipment, Transit, Street Lighting, Storm Sewers, Road and Sidewalk Maintenance.
- Includes repaving of roadways and the reconstruction of concrete sidewalks.
- 28 parks with ball diamonds, playgrounds, tennis courts, beach volleyball, outdoor basketball, picnic shelters, swim areas, disc golf, beach volleyball, dog park, boat launch, community garden, soccer fields and skateboard park. Call 705-526-4770 or email csr@midland.ca.

Engineering

- Responsible for capital works projects including the design and tendering for road reconstruction works including replacement of aged water, sewer and storm infrastructure.
- Reviews plans for new residential, commercial, industrial and institutional development to ensure all services meet the Town's Engineering Development Design Standards.
- Develop and maintain GIS services for all town departments including projects such as asset management, inventories, and mapping support for internal departments as well as developers and consultants.

Culture, Tourism and Special Events

- Special events include the Butter Tart Festival, Canada Day, Ontario 55+ Summer Games, Winterfest, Kids Fishing Derby, Dockside Tuesdays, Tugfest, Watercross, Brookside Music, Cycle Simcoe, Culture Midland Awards, festivals, and general tourism.

- Midland is one of nine municipal members of the Severn Sound Environmental Association (SSEA).

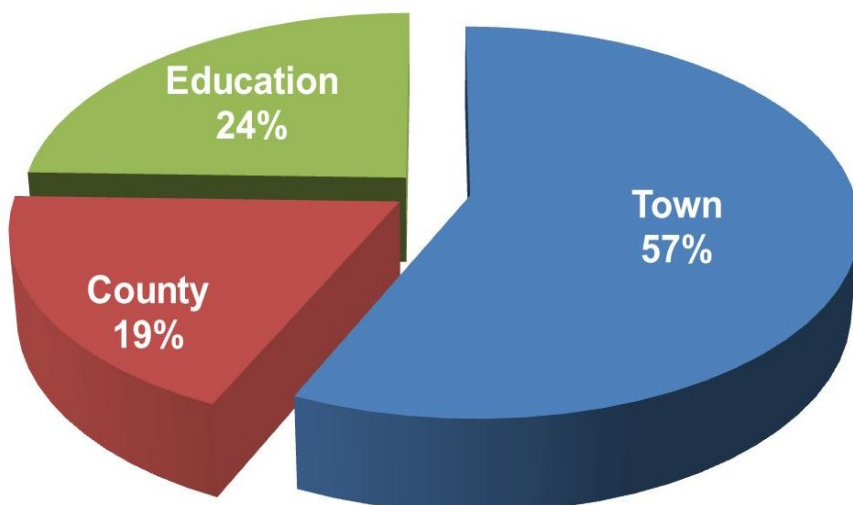
Water & Sewer Services—Billed Separately
