BY-LAW 2019-85

By-law to Establish and Approve the Fees and Charges of the Town of Midland

WHEREAS Section 391 (1) of the Municipal Act S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended authorizes a municipality to impose fees or charges on persons for services or activities, for costs payable for services or activities and for the use of property including property under its control; and

WHEREAS Section 398 (2) of the Municipal Act 2001, S.O. 2001 provides that the treasurer of a municipality may add fees or charges imposed by a municipality to the tax roll and collect them in the same manner as municipal taxes; and,

WHEREAS all fees or charges imposed pursuant to the By-law are due and payable at the time the services are provided; and,

WHEREAS Section 69 of the Planning Act R.S.O. 1990 provides that a municipality may prescribe a tariff of fees for the processing of applications made in respect of planning matters; and,

WHEREAS Council passed By-law 2011-7 on the Twenty-eighth day of April, 2011, to establish a Composite Fee Schedule for the Town of Midland for services and activities provided or done by the municipality within the Clerks, Treasury, Fire, Planning, Engineering and Transit Departments;

AND WHEREAS Council has reviewed the schedule of fees and charges and now deems it expedient to repeal By-law 2011-7, as amended, and provide a revised Composite Fee Schedule;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF MIDLAND HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the fees and charges set out for municipal services and activities and for the use of municipal property set out in the following Schedules of this By-law are hereby approved and deemed to form part of this by-law:

- Schedule "A" – Clerks and By-law
- Schedule "B" - Finance
- Schedule "C" – Fire and Emergency Services
- Schedule "D" - Planning
- Schedule "E" - Infrastructure
- Schedule "F" - Transit
- Schedule "G" – Community Services

2. That By-law 2011-7, as amended, is hereby repealed.
3. That By-law 2019-32 is hereby repealed effective January 1, 2020.
4. That any By-law or By-laws, or parts of any By-law or By-law that are inconsistent with this By-law are hereby deemed repealed.
5. That this by-law comes into force and effect as of January 1, 2020.
