

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF MIDLAND

BY-LAW 2020-58

A By-law to dissolve the 'Ward System of Electoral Representation' for the Corporation of Town of Midland, and Institute an 'At-Large System of Electoral Representation' and to Repeal By-law 79-58

WHEREAS Section 222 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended provides that a municipality may pass a by-law to dissolve existing wards.

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Midland adopted on May 27, 2015 by resolution that the existing Wards be dissolved and institute an 'At-Large System' of Electoral Representation;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Town of Midland hereby enacts as follows:

1. THAT Ward 1, Ward 2 and Ward 3 hereby be dissolved in their entirety;
2. THAT the Ward System in the Town of Midland shall be replaced by an 'At-large' Electoral System for the Municipality;
3. THAT the Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to do all things necessary to give effect to this By-law, including giving the required notice.
4. THAT this by-law shall come into effect subject to and in accordance with Section 222 (8) of the Municipal Act for the 2022 Election;
5. THAT By-law 79-58 being a by-law to authorize an application to the Ontario Municipal Board for an Order to re-divide the Corporation into Wards and all Amendments to the Same, Any By-law or By-laws, or parts of any By-law or By-laws that are inconsistent with this By-law are hereby deemed repealed.
