### Transfer Zone Details

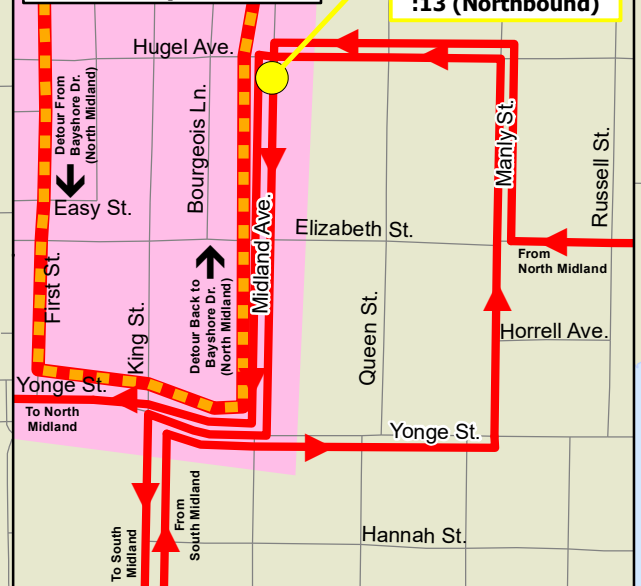
The Midland and Penetanguishene buses both now go to all transfer zone locations. Please board any bus between Superstore and Mountainview Mall and it will take you to the transfer point at Huronia Mall.

Both bus routes head to Superstore first, Mountainview Mall next and finally Huronia Mall. They then travel to GBGH before continuing on with the rest of their routes.

As a result of road closures for Ontario's Best Butter Tart Festival, the Midland Route requires a detour. On Saturday, June 8 only, Midland buses will now turn right onto First Street from Bayshore Drive and proceed south to Yonge Street before turning left. Buses will then travel eastward along Yonge Street until turning left onto Midland Avenue. Finally, buses will turn right onto Bayshore Drive and rejoin the regular route. The main downtown stop will remain at the corner of Midland and Hugel Avenues. Please be patient as delays may occur due to the detour and high traffic volume. We apologize for any inconvenience. Midpen Transit Service is FREE for all riders on Saturday, June 8.

### Switch to a Single Midland (Red) Route

Previously, Midland had two routes (North and South) served by a single bus. For improved clarity, this has been switched to show as a single red route. The actual travelled route and arrival times have NOT changed. The route begins downtown and goes to South Midland first before returning downtown and heading to North Midland.
