**NOTICE OF INTENTION TO PASS AN AMENDING BY-
LAW TO REMOVE A HOLDING “H” SYMBOL**

In accordance with Sections 34 & 36 of the *Planning Act* R.S.O. 1990 c.P.13., the Town of Midland intends to pass a Zoning By-law Amendment to remove a Holding “H” Symbol from PT OF LT 105 CON 1 WPR TINY BEING PART 1 ON PL 51R39428 TOWN OF MIDLAND, municipally known as 574 Balm Beach Road East (‘subject lands’). See location map on the reverse of this notice.

The subject lands are zoned Highway Commercial Exemption with a Holding “H” Symbol (HC-2-H). Section 3.36 of the Town of Midland Zoning By-law outlines that the removal of a Holding “H” Symbol is to occur by way of a Zoning By-law amendment. The requirements for the removal of the Holding “H” Symbol from the subject lands are:

1. Obtaining a Private Septic System Use Permit, Final Inspection Report or equivalent from the Chief Building Official or appropriate agency.

The Owner of the subject lands has fulfilled these requirements and has applied for a Zoning By-law amendment to remove the Holding “H” Symbol.

Pursuant to By-law 2025-50, being the delegated authority By-law of the Corporation of the Town of Midland, the authority to lift a Holding “H” Symbol has been delegated to staff. As such, please be advised that the removal of the Holding “H” Symbol is to be completed 14 days after the circulation of this notice.
