**Backyard Bonfire Season**

- Residents must purchase a burn permit from the Town office.
- Before burning, check the fire rating.

**Fire Rating**

- Call the Town or see our website to check the fire rating.

**Safety Checks**

- Test smoke and carbon monoxide alarms monthly.
- Replace alarms that are over 10 years old.
- Practice your home fire escape plan regularly.
