



New Convenience Fee When Paying by Credit Card

What are we doing?

The Town will charge a convenience fee of 2.4% to credit card payments for transactions in the following categories:

- Invoices greater than \$3,000
- Development Application fees
- Building Permits
- Property Tax Bill payments
- Water and Wastewater Bill payments



Why are we doing this?

The Town is charged fees by credit card companies when customers make payments by credit card. Adding this 'convenience' fee to credit card payments recovers these additional costs incurred by the Town. No profit is made by the Town from these fees.

Customers who prefer to pay by cash, cheque, debit, or through online banking options will not be charged this fee.

Fees approved by Council June 14, 2023, as per:

- By-law 2023-34 – Building Permit Fee By-law.
- By-law 2023-38 - Amend Fees and Charges By-Law 2023-8.

What's Happening this Summer?

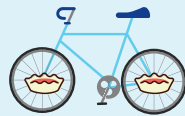
August 19-20: Tugboat Festival with Ribfest

Midland Seniors (65+): Free Harbour Parking and Transit

Free Harbour Parking:




Register at the Town office to park at the Harbour Parking lot for free. Must provide a valid drivers license (showing 65+ and Midland residency) and personal vehicle registration (proof of ownership).

Free Conventional Transit:






Register at the Town office to ride with Mid-Pen Transit for free. Must provide proof of Midland residency and age (65+). Riders will be photographed and issued a transit card.

How to Pay for Downtown Parking

Pay with Coin

1. Press green button to start. 
2. Insert exact change until desired parking, \$1/ hour*. 
3. Press green button.
4. Take ticket and display! 

Pay with Card

1. Press green button to start. 
2. Select parking time with buttons.
3. Pay with Debit or Credit:
 - Debit: Tap card. 
 - Credit: Tap or insert into card reader slot. 
4. Press green button. 
5. Take ticket and display! 

On-Street Parking Downtown

- Paid parking Monday through Saturday, free on Sundays.
- Pay at the meter (\$1/hour) and display on your dash!

Harbour Parking

- Paid parking Monday - Sunday (24/7).
- Pay at the meter (\$1.50/hour) and display on your dash!*
