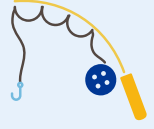


What's Happening this Summer?

August 19-20: Tugboat Festival with Ribfest

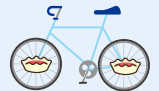
- From 10:00am - 5:00pm Saturday and Sunday at Midland Harbour.
