

## THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF MIDLAND

### **BY-LAW 2023-8**

A By-law to Establish and Approve the Fees and Charges of the Town of Midland and to repeal By-law 2022-15, as amended.

**WHEREAS** Section 391 (1) of the *Municipal Act* S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended authorizes a municipality to impose fees or charges on persons for services or activities, for costs payable for services or activities and for the use of property including property under its control; and

**WHEREAS** Section 398 (2) of the *Municipal Act* 2001, S.O. 2001 provides that the treasurer of a municipality may add fees or charges imposed by a municipality to the tax roll and collect them in the same manner as municipal taxes; and,

**WHEREAS** all fees or charges imposed pursuant to the By-law are due and payable at the time the services are provided; and,

**WHEREAS** Section 69 of the *Planning Act* R.S.O. 1990 provides that a municipality may prescribe a tariff of fees for the processing of applications made in respect of planning matters; and,

**WHEREAS** Council passed By-law 2022-15 on the second day of March, 2022, and amended by By-law 2022-30 on fourth day of May, 2022, to establish a Composite Fee Schedule for the Town of Midland for services and activities provided or done by the municipality within the By-law, Clerks, Community Services, Engineering, Finance, Fire, Operations and Planning Divisions;

**AND WHEREAS** Council has reviewed the schedule of fees and charges and now deems it expedient to repeal By-law 2022-15, as amended and provide the Composite Fees and Charges for 2023;

**NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF MIDLAND HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. That the fees and charges established for municipal services, activities and for the use of municipal property set out in the following Schedule of this By-law are hereby approved and deemed to form part of this by-law:
