



The Midland Police Services Board was established in 2018 when the contract for police services was entered into with the Ontario Provincial Police.

The Board is provincially mandated under section 10 of the *Police Services Act* and is a five person Board. The Board is comprised of the Head of Council, one member of Council, one community member and two Provincial appointees.

The role of the Board is to:

- Participate in the selection of the detachment commander of the detachment
- Generally determine objectives and priorities for police services in conjunction with the detachment commander
- Establish, with consultation of the detachment commander, local priorities for local police services
- Receive reports from the detachment commander
- Review the administration of the company under Part V of the Act and receive reports on the administration of the complaints system.

Attached is the 2023 draft budget which reflects a small reduction from the 2022 budgeted amount.
