Subject: Indigenous Community Consultation Follow Up

The purpose of this memo to summarize an additional point of contact completed with Indigenous Communities following Public Information Centre No. 2, prior to issue of the Notice of Completion, and is not intended to provide a full summary of the Indigenous Community consultation completed for this project. For full details pertaining to Indigenous Community consultation, inquiries and responses provided, please refer to the Master Plan document prepared for this project.

The Ministry of Environment, Conservation, and Parks (MECP) was consulted at the project start to obtain direction on which Indigenous Communities should be contacted for this project as their office assumed the role from the Ministry of Indigenous Affairs in advising which Indigenous Communities should be contacted for specific projects. An email was subsequently sent to MECP on December 21, 2018 requesting input. MECP responded January 10, 2019 advising that the following should be included on the project contact list:

- Chippewas of Georgina Island
- Chippewas of Rama First Nation
- Beausoleil First Nation
- Huron-Wendat Nation
- Chippewas of Nawash First Nation
- Chippewas of Saugeen
- Wahta Mohawk First Nation
- Moose Deer Point First Nation
- Metis Nation of Ontario, Georgian Bay Traditional Territory Consultation Committee

In addition, based on the Town of Midland established Protocol Agreement (i.e. By-law 2018-32) with Beausoleil First Nation the following communities were identified as key Indigenous contacts for this project:

- Huron Wendat
- Metis Nation of Ontario
- Georgian Bay Native Friendship Centre

Given the limited response received following issue of the Notice of Commencement/PIC No. 1 and issue of the Notice of PIC No. 2, a follow up was completed with the Indigenous Communities to make certain that they were aware of the project and to generally confirm if they have any questions or concerns. The follow up process consisted of the following:

- Follow Up Email Issued Dec-17, 2019 – One email issued to all Indigenous Communities on Project Contact List.
- Follow up Phone Call Jan. 9 & 10, 2020 - Andrea Potter (AECOM) phoned all those on the list that had not responded.
- Emails Following Phone Calls - Following the phone calls additional emails were issued in response to a request by certain FN contacts to forward the December 17th email to alternate contacts.
