

Notice of Public Workshop

The Town of Midland is preparing a Waterfront Mater Plan that will create a guide for future decisions about the Town's waterfront, expected by Fall 2025.

Members of the public are invited to attend to learn about and share their feedback on the draft vision for the waterfront.

Three public workshop sessions are planned. Each session will begin with a presentation and will be followed by workshop activities. The presentation will discuss the current state of the waterfront, including land use, access, natural heritage, boating, and recreation. Ideas will be shared on topics like trails, vehicle access, green spaces, recreation areas, the marina, boating, stewardship and direction for development applications. Participants will also be encouraged to share their thoughts on the team's early ideas and suggest additional improvements for the Town's 13 km of waterfront along Georgian Bay.
