



Mayoral Decision

Decision Number: MDE-2026-9
Date: May 20, 2026
Purpose: To give written approval of the By-law(s) passed at the Regular Meeting of Council with Closed Session held on May 20, 2026.

Authority: Section 284.11 of the Municipal Act, 2001 provides the Mayor with the authority to veto a By-law passed by Council if they believe it interferes with a prescribed Provincial priority and that written approval of the By-law can be given by the Mayor.
