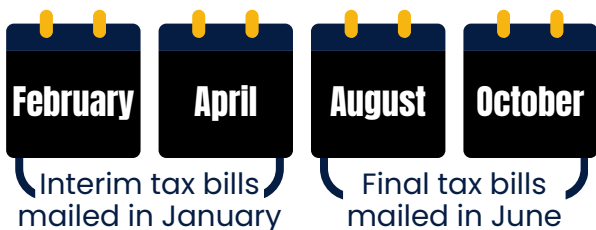




Your property taxes

Effective 2025

Property taxes are due each year in:



- Interim tax billing is based on 50% of the previous year's tax levy.
- Final tax billing is based on the current annual tax levy minus the interim amount billed.

Contact us if you do not receive your bill – it is your responsibility to pay by the due date to avoid penalties.

Who determines my property's assessment?

- The Municipal Property Assessment Corporation (MPAC) determines the value of your property.
- Contact MPAC (1-866-296-6722 or mpac.ca) about property assessment cycles and values.

Pay for your property tax bill:

- through a Pre-Authorized Payment plan,
- at the Municipal office with cheque, debit card, cash, or credit card (2.4% fee will apply), or through secure drop box,
- at most banks in person, telephone banking, or through personal online banking (use your roll number as the account number – no dashes).

Payments must be received by the Town by the due date(s). Interest is charged at a rate of 1.25% per month (15% annum) on all property taxes past due.

Apply to start your property tax Pre-Authorized Payment plan (PAP):

- easily apply online or in-person,
- once enrolled your PAP will continue yearly.

Choose the plan that suits you:

10-Month plan

(monthly January – October)

- Refer to your Property Tax bills for the PAP monthly deduction.

Installment Due Date plan

(tax bill due dates)

- Refer to your Property Tax bills for the PAP due date deduction.
