### Position Summary

---

Reporting to the Tourism and Special Events Planner, the Street Volunteer will act as a festival ambassador.

A volunteer T-shirt, reusable water bottle, and lunch voucher will be provided.

### Duties & Responsibilities

---

- Assists vendors by responding to their questions throughout the day.
- Morning Shift: Directs vendors in your block to their booth space.
- Ensures entrances to downtown businesses are open and not blocked.
- Assists festivalgoers with general inquiries and acts as a friendly, festival ambassador.
- Afternoon Shift: Assists with festival clean-up. Ensures vendors place their garbage in the large garbage bins located on the side streets (not in the garbage cans on the sidewalks) and that vendors do not dismantle their booths or leave before 5 p.m. Volunteers should note and report any transgressions to Town of Midland festival staff.

### Qualifications and Requirements

---

- Strong customer service skills.

### Effort/Physical Demands

---

- Physical demand requires standing and walking.
- Visual attention to health and safety compliance and personal safety while performing volunteer duties.

### Working Conditions

---

- This is an outdoor, all-weather event; there may be exposure to sun, heat, rain, and wind. Volunteers should dress accordingly, wear comfortable shoes, and wear sunscreen.
