Position Summary

Reporting to the Event Coordinator, the Contest Servers will assist with serving the contest tarts to the judges and to the members of the public in Rotary Hall in the Midland Cultural Centre at the Egg Farmers of Ontario Butter Tart Contest.

A volunteer T-shirt, reusable water bottle, and lunch voucher will be provided.

Duties & Responsibilities

- Delivers tarts to judges as cued by the Event Coordinator.
- Assists with getting beverages, extra cutlery, napkins, etc. for judges.
- Serves samples of butter tarts to visitors seated in Rotary Hall in a fair manner.
- Assists with cleaning the judging tables and preparing them for the next round.
- Works cooperatively with festival staff, volunteers, and Midland Cultural Centre staff.

Qualifications and Requirements

- Strong customer service skills.
- Organizational skills.
- Ability to remain calm when it gets busy.

Effort/Physical Demands

- Physical demand requires standing, sitting, and walking.
- Visual attention for health and safety compliance and personal safety while performing volunteer duties.
